



TAPAS MENU

Tapa comes from the Spanish word Taper, to cover. Tapas tradition began when King Alfonso X of Castile recovered from an illness by drinking wine mixed with small dishes between meals. He then made it illegal for wine to be served to customers in taverns unless it was accompanied by a small snack or 'tapa'. This word became a kind of loop hole in the law to allow drinkers to consume alcohol. Tapas now enjoys a worldwide appeal as a highly social able way to eat, making them the perfect choice for sharing.
